## PLANNING YOUR CLASS TRIP

- **1.** Pick-A Trip. Pick the experience you would like your students to have and how many days you will be at Shekinah.
- **2.** After confirming date availability, please submit a Facility Rental Application form (online).
- 3. Make a deposit. This is required to secure your booking.
- **4.** Shekinah's Program Director will contact you to confirm your booking.
- **5.** Stay in touch. School groups are asked to email the Program Director two weeks ahead of their booking to confirm arrival and departure times, numbers, and schedule.
- **6.** Good weather is not a guarantee. Please check ahead of time and make sure students are prepared well, as this significantly impacts how much they enjoy their trip.

\*If weather gets in the way of outdoor activities Shekinah staff will lead your students in indoor activities.



### PICK-A-TRIP

#### **Adventure Trip**

(Recommended for Spring)

Shekinah's Adventure outdoor experience is a great way to end off the year as it is less of an educational experience and more of a treat. We start our day with a group hike on Ravine Trail, Shekinah's most scenic route. This brings us out to the features of this trip, Zipline and Climbing Wall. From this point on whether you are here for 2 days, 3 days, or just 1 we take care of all the activities. We just ask you to provide supervision for meals, down time, and at night.

#### **ACCOMMODATIONS**

Day groups: Home base is the shelter in the field. Chalet washrooms open. Chalet hall available for rainy days.

Overnight groups:

Chalet- sleeps 40 with a curtain to divide the building in half.

Cabins- sleep 40+

#### **Food and Water**

Full kitchen available. Please make arrangements in advance to use the kitchen.

Shekinah's water is safe to drink, and we want you to enjoy it.

#### SITE RULES AND REGULATIONS

No pets allowed. We are a natural and safe space for wildlife, and for those with pet allergies!

Smoking is only permitted outside and in designated areas. Please ask Shekinah staff where these places are.



#### **SUPERVISION**

We recommend a ratio of 1 supervisor for every 10 students. We expect this level of supervision of the students even when a Shekinah staff member is leading an activity. Your adults are responsible for supervising students during transitions and at night. Shekinah staff are available to work with your school between 9am - 5pm. We are available to give suggestions for possible evening activities at camp and then you will be responsible for leading these activities.

Please remember to bring your own FIRST AID KIT!!!! This is important in the case of injury or an emergency!

#### **ADDITIONAL NOTES**

Your group is responsible for any damages incurred over and above regular wear and tear on Shekinah property.

Food services, medical drug supervision, and food preparation are required by the adults accompanying the group for the duration of the stay.
